

Station Leaders Info Sheet



If you receive this note, you have volunteered as a station leader for Project Plant-a-Seed. The purpose of this program is to introduce and educate middle school students to their environment and careers in natural resource management. More specifically, you will serve as a leader to a field station for a three day period in September. Be prepared to have fun and to learn as much as lead!

Here are some things to remember for leaders:

- Be familiar with the station content and equipment
- Visit your site location before the field trip dates
- Field trips will be scheduled from 9:00AM-2:00 PM, September 19-21 at Hone Quarry Recreation Area or Sandy Bottom Park in Bridgewater.
- Attend the field training on September 1 at Sandy Bottom Park
- Receive and review your individual Station Package by September 1. These will be distributed at the field training or via email at that time.

Your Station Package will include:

1. Specific goals and instructions to the station you have chosen (Riparian buffers, Macros, or Water Quality).
2. Field Trip Itinerary
3. Directions and Maps of assigned sites.
4. Copies of station data sheets and sampling instructions
